

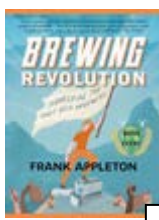

Frank Appleton, who is a resident of Edgewood, currently was nominated for his book, 'Brewing Revolution, Pioneering The Craft Beer Movement'. Frank was long listed with six other books.

The award is prestigious award from the National Business Book awards with a cash prize of \$30,000 to the most outstanding Canadian book.

The National Business Book Award jury is: Peter Mansbridge, Chief Correspondent, CBC Television News. Deirdre McMurdy, Adjudicator; David Denison, businessman and Chair of Hydro One; author and publisher Anna Porter and The Honourable Pamela Wallin.

The criteria for judging include: originality, relevance, excellence of writing, thoroughness of research and depth of analysis. The winner will be announced April 24, 2017.

Annual Art Show

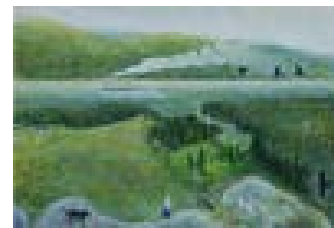
Door Prizes!
