Another COVID reminder

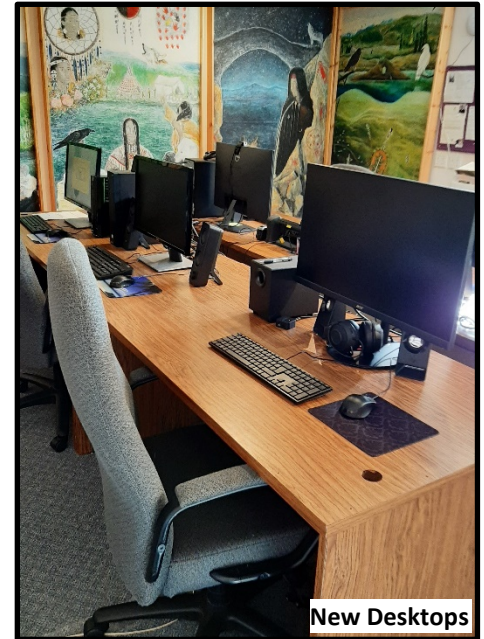
