Are You Still Thinking About COVID-19?

The government of B.C. is continuing to roll out mandates concerning COVID-19.

Starting October 30th, 2021, travellers will need to be fully vaccinated to use federally regulated methods of travel. This includes national and international air travel, VIA Rail and Rocky Mountaineer trains. The government is claiming that they will grant one month of leniency concerning this regulation, but after November 30th this mandate will be strictly enforced.

Furthermore, B.C. will begin prioritizing high risk people for booster vaccinations beginning in November 2021 – January 2022. After January of next year everyone in B.C. will be eligible for the booster shot.
