Having trouble with your internet? Try this before calling:

To troubleshoot your internet connection, you should first power cycle your radio.

Step 1- Turn off your computer. When it has shut down completely, proceed to the next step.

Step 2- If you have a router, remove the power cable. Wait thirty seconds.

Step 3-Next, remove the power cable from the POE (either at the wall or at the POE). Wait thirty seconds.

Step 4-Plug your POE back in.

Step 5-Plug your router back in.

Step 6-Turn your computer back on.

When it is completely powered up, you should have your Internet connection back. If this procedure hasn't restored your connection, you will need to call John at 250 808 0271. With the smoke in the air, it's a bit of a no brainer to be extra mindful around fire smart practices. Here are a few to keep in mind: Complete fire ban is in effect

- Don't set off pyrotechnics.
- Carefully dispose of smoking materials.

- Mow the lawn earlier in the day before temperatures
- No off-roading in grasslands or areas with heavy brush during the dry season.
- On your property, follow FireSmart tips from the FireSmart Guide.
- Pay attention to fire bans.
- Be mindful of fires in your area.
