

Protect yourself against phone and email scams.

Your best protection is to be careful when you receive phone calls and emails from anyone you do not know. Do not give out any personal information to anyone you are not sure about. A fake email can look very real, never click on any link, or give out any financial or personal information. Banks or government agencies will not call or email you for this information. The “Grandparent” or Emergency scam is someone requesting you send money for an accident, injury or arrest. This is just a way for the scammer to get access to your bank account. It is best to get proof that the person who is asking for money is actually your relative or friend. Ask the caller a question that only your relative or friend would be able to answer. If a call or email sounds suspicious, just hang up or delete the email.
