- Trained for all types of emergency trauma with BC Ambulance Service on transfers
- Advanced Cardiac Life Support, Certified Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation level 3

Outpost Services

- Referrals to dietician, respiration, therapist, physiotherapy, blood work, 5-day week
- Electrocardiogram
- Sperometry testing-lung functions
- Blood pressure, blood sugar, Hbg-Cholesterol testing and monitoring
- Dietary counseling/weight loss
- Health heart screening
- Cholesterol and lipid clinics
- Drug and alcoholic support/counseling,
- Prenatal care (delivery of babies if needed)
- Well women's clinic twice weekly
- Mental health care
- Home visits - Long Term Care/Home Care program affiliated with Nakusp

Clinics at the Outpost Hospital

- Doctor Lea and Doctor Cook come monthly, 2 clinics per month
- Foot Care Nurse, Monthly
- Dr. Kievit, Chiropractor, from Vernon Monthly
- Registered Massage Therapist, Allen McAllister, Weekly
- Public Health Nurse every two months for babies and immunization
- Diabetic Clinics twice yearly
- School Lunch Program, Edgewood Elementary
- Diagnose, assess, prescribe medications and over the counter medication
- Referrals to doctors in Nakusp
- Constant communications with doctors about meds, diseases
- Ongoing work with our community outside our clinic
