At this point we have finished most of the preparatory and preliminary jobs on the project, including: collecting, scanning, and processing pictures, gathering permissions to use materials, and gathering material to use through research or interviews. We do continue to accept new material as it becomes available or as it becomes necessary to fill in holes in our info, but at this point we have all of the material we planned to access at the start of the project. We have finalized versions of approximately nine hundred pictures which we have planned use of in the project, and several hundred more that we hope to find ways to use, perhaps as galleries if I can not find another place for them. We have rough versions of eight sections of the site (distinct topics) with writing, pictures, and design all in place, but without final polished text. We have drafts of text for several more sections and within the next one to two weeks we should be able to turn out the remaining sections of the website at a rate of about one section per day, text, layout, and pictures included. On this schedule, we hope to have the items in the storyboard done far enough in advance for significant polishing of text, and the possible addition of material which is still arriving such as some interviews and modern springtime pictures of the area, along with some proposed activities pages for kids or educational purposes.
