Saint Valentine's Day

Saint Valentine's Day, is an annual celebration of love and affection between intimate companions. The day is named after one or more early Christian martyrs named Saint Valentine, and was established by Pope Gelasius I in 496 AD.

The Valentines honored of February 14 are Valentine of Rome and Valentine of Terni. Valentine of Rome was a priest in Rome who was martyred about AD 269 and was buried on the Via Flaminia (An ancient Roman road across the Apennine Mountains).

Valentine of Terni became a bishop of Terni about AD 197 and is said to have been martyred during the persecution of Emperor Aurelian (About 274 AD). He is also buried on the Via Flaminia, but in a different location than Valentine of Rome.


