## Phase 2 Inonoaklin Valley and Edgewood Broadband Project

Why is this project needed? How will it benefit the Community of Edgewood?

- Perform a site and client survey of the northeast and northwest of our rural community to identify the delivery to these areas.

The Edgewood Community Internet Society will find creative ways to work with governments, communities, and infrastructure providers and funding sources and service providers.
